A Brief History

Inaugurated on 10th July, 1954 by Dr, C.P. Ramaswamy Iyer, the then Vice-Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University, Vasant Kanya Mahavidyalaya, a postgraduate institution has withstood the challenges of time to leave its imprint in the world of women's education only because of the fact that it draws sustenance from the vision of Dr. Annie Besant, Mahamana Madan Mohan Malaviya, Dr. Rohit Mehta and others who worked to link up education with culture and balance freedom with responsibility. With a holistic end in mind, the college pursues the motto "education as service", so that the students become responsible citizens, able to serve the community. The academic, the co-curricular and the extra-curricular events brace the young girls to face, understand and address the challenges of the ever-changing society.

A group of extremely efficient, committed and qualified teachers under the able administration of open minded Principals have successfully tried to achieve the goals for which the college has been established. The college at present is teaching 14 subjects in Arts and Social Science streams at UG level i.e. *English, Sanskrit, Hindi, Philosophy, AIHC & Archaeology, Music (Vocal), Music (Instrumental), Painting, Home Science, History, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology, Economics* along with PG and Ph.D courses in 5 subjects i.e *Hindi, English, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology.* In 2020-21, post-graduation in six more subjects – AIHC & Archaeology, History, Political Science, Philosophy and Sanskrit will be introduced alongwith Geography at undergraduate level. The college runs two certificate courses under self-financing scheme -Spoken English and Fashion Designing.

V.K.M. has a group of 47 qualified and competent faculties who have been appointed as per U.G.C. norms. As the pursuit of excellence happens to be a continuous process, workshops, seminars, lecture series, faculty development programmes are held from time to time. These upgrade the information and efficiency of the teachers. The outcomes of such positive endeavors reflect on the quality of teaching.

. The college is fortunate to have students from many states of India as admission is through All India Entrance Test conducted by BHU. The college follows the reservation policy of the Government of India in admission. SC/ST, OBC & PH are accordingly admitted in various UG/PG courses.

Academic Achievements -

In the academic session 2018-19, 1296 students were enrolled in the undergraduate courses and 268 in Post-graduate courses. This session 21 students were enrolled in Fashion Designing certificate course and 15 students in Spoken English Certificate course. In the current session, 1 new Research Scholar was enrolled in Department of Home Science. At present the total number of Research Scholars enrolled under the supervision of our faculty members is 59.

- Workshop on *Data Screening and Preparation for Statistical Analysis through SPSS*: A one day workshop on "Data Screening and Preparation for Statistical Analysis through SPSS" was organized by Department of Pyschology on 30.03.2019. At present, the library subscribes to 06 journals, 20 magazines, 10 daily newspapers. It uses customized programme LIBSYS and is fully automated. After full automation, the titles of books in the library can be easily accessed by the students through computers from anywhere in the College. This has helped in saving the time and energy of the students which was earlier used to access the books manually. In the reading room of the library, xerox facility is available. Also computers with Wi-Fi connections are made available so the students can enhance knowledge in concerned fields. This session a book fair was organized from 9-11 October, 2018.
