About the Online Workshop

The education policy of the 21st century, NEP 2020, replaces the 34-year-old National Policy of Education 1986 with an intention to bring changes in the educational structure of the country. Built on the foundation of access, equity, quality, affordability and accountability, this policy is aligned to the 2030 agenda for sustainable development, which aims to transform India into a vibrant knowledge society and global knowledge superpower by making both school and higher education holistic, flexible and multidisciplinary. Suited to the 21st century needs, the aim of this policy document is bringing out the unique capabilities of each student.

The National Education Policy 2020 covers school education, higher education and other key areas of focal concern such as adult education, promoting

Indian knowledge and online education. The policy seeks to restructure school education and pedagogy in a new format of 5+3+3+4. The structure of NEP 2020 emphasises a foundation stage (5 years), preparatory stage (3 years), middle stage (3 years) and higher stage (4 years) so that school education can be made relevant to the needs and interests of learners at different developmental stages.

The NEP 2020 aims to achieve a universal foundation of literacy and numeracy in primary schools by 2025 for the public and private schools that are managed and aided by the central government and accredited on the same criteria, benchmark and processes. The gross enrollment ratio (GER) from pre-school to secondary education is the target to be achieved. The medium of expression should be the student's mother tongue or the regional language with an emphasis on three-language formula to be implemented in schools where learning two of the three languages should be the concern.

NEP 2020 promotes open schooling system, it aims to build the overall personality of students, strengthen infrastructure for women and distance learning, online education and increase the use of technology in education.

Moreover, the National Research Foundation (NRF) will be set up to boost research work in the country.

According to the vision of the policy document, it is required in the 21st century higher education to develop good quality thought, just and creative individuals. It must enable an individual to study one or more specialised area of interest and also develop character, ethical and constitutional values, intellectual curiosity, scientific temper and creativity.

The purpose of quality higher education is, therefore, more than the creation of greater opportunities for employment. It presents the key

to more vibrant, socially engaged, cooperative communities, productive culture, and innovative progressive nation.

This workshop will try to orient an interdisciplinary outlook on the New Education Policy 2020, with some sort of comparative understanding of previous and current policies, analytic and critical evaluation of its shortcomings and strengths, imaginative vision to foresee

The possible challenges in its implementation and benefits thereafter.

The workshop will bring many learned scholars on one platform to enrich the understanding of NEP 2020 and disseminate properly the vision and mission of NEP 2020.






